Update

We received notice yesterday, that an Associate tested positive for the presence of coronavirus in our most recent round of surveillance testing. The Associate had a last day worked of Sunday, October 11 and is at home under self-quarantine. Because this positive case was found in our last round of County-required testing, we are required to extend testing for at least two more rounds. The next round will occur for Associates and Resident starting on Wednesday, October 21 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.; and 4:30-6:30 p.m.

Exercising extreme caution and in accordance with guidance from the Arizona Department of Health Services, all Residents are under full quarantine in their rooms; and, all Resident visits have been temporarily postponed. Associates continue to strictly follow the required infection control protocols including wearing personal protective equipment (PPE) and carefully following hand hygiene and disinfection procedures at all times. We will keep you updated on the results and visitation.

Important Information

** LifeStream closely follows the Maricopa County Department of Health Guidelines to determine when it is safe for an Associate to return to work. County Health guidance states that an individual with symptoms and a positive PCR (nasal swab) test must stay home for at least 10 days since symptoms first appeared AND be free of symptoms for at least 24 hours.*
